Childcare Family,

I hope this letter finds you and your family doing well even among these delicate and sometimes fearful times. We trust you are doing all you can to keep you and your family safe during this time and wanted to keep you informed as to how we are working to do the same. In this letter, we just wanted to cover three very quick things.

First, we wanted you to be aware we have increased the frequency and intensified our cleaning and disinfectant procedures over the last few weeks to follow as closely as we can the CDC recommendations. This means in addition to our normal cleaning procedures, you may find teachers who are typically in the classrooms wiping down hallway walls, handrails, light switches, and other responsibilities. Our playground equipment is being cleaned before and after every use. We have also limited our facility usage to as minimal classrooms as possible. Our classrooms and gatherings have been limited to less than 10 people at a time. We have also limited nonessential visitors into our building. We do not want you to be alarmed by these practices, but to be aware these are our proactive measures to continue to keep our facility clean and your children safe.
